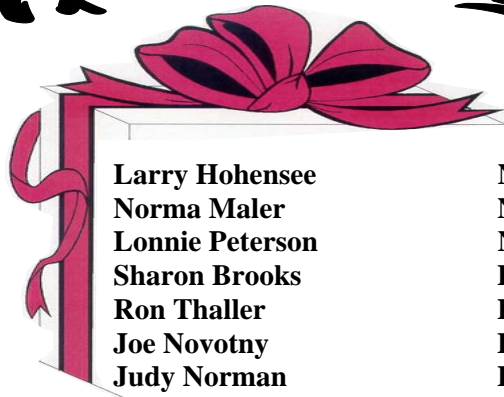

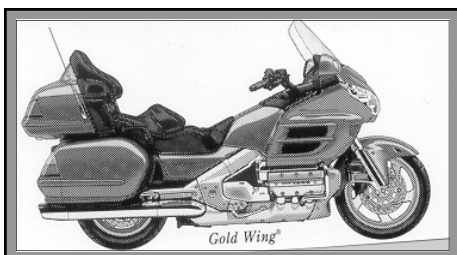

## Down Right Handy Tips

### Pizza Reheat

Heat up leftover pizza in a non-stick skillet on top of the stove, set heat to med-low and heat until warm. This keeps the crust crispy. No more soggy micro pizza.



### Easy Deviled Eggs

Put cooked egg yolks in a zip lock bag. Seal, mash until they are all broken up. Add remainder of ingredients, reseal, keep mashing it up mixing thoroughly, then cut the tip off the baggy and squeeze the mixture into the cook egg white. Just throw the bag away when done making for easy clean up.

### Expanding Frosting

When you buy a container of cake frosting from the store, whip it with your mixer for a few minutes. You can double it in size. You get to frost more cake/cupcakes with the same amount and you also eat less sugar/calories per serving. (Works with butter too....Make your own "whipped" butter.

### Reheat Refrigerated bread

Place a cup of water in the microwave when you warm biscuits, pancakes, or muffins that were refrigerated. The increased moisture will keep the food moist and help it reheat faster.



### Broken Glass

Use a dry cotton ball to pick up little broken pieces of glass. . . The fibers catch the ones you can't see.

### Flexible Vacuum

To get something out of a heat register or under the fridge, add an empty paper towel roll or empty gift wrap roll to your vacuum. It can be bent or flattened to get in narrow openings.

### Mine !!!

If you purchase a new bike for your child, place their picture inside the handle bar before placing the grips on. If the bike is stolen and later recovered, remove the grip and there is the proof as to who owns the bike.



### Reduce Static Cling

Pin a small safety pin to the seam of your slip and you will not have a clingy skirt or dress. Same thing works with slacks that cling when wearing panty hose. Place a pin in the seam of the slacks and—viola—static is gone.

### Measuring Cups

Before you pour sticky substances into a measuring cup, fill it with hot water. Dump out the hot water, but don't dry the cup. Next, add your ingredient, such as peanut butter and watch how easily it comes right out of the measuring cup.

### Foggy Windshield?
